Saturday, 26 April – Wintery weather too tough for track meet but just right for Big Butte Run.

Snow, rain and cold weather caused several area track meets to be canceled on Saturday, including a junior high meet in Dillon which freed seventh grade runner Heather LaFontaine of Deer Lodge to compete in the Big Butte Run 5K, and she won the event in 21:32, 33 seconds faster than runner-up Joan Downey of Butte. Defending 5K champion Maggie Smith of Butte finished third in the event today with a time of 22:16. Last year, Smith established the still standing 5K course record of 20:41. LaFontaine said she tried to push hard during the middle of the race to ward off the threats of Downey and Smith.

In the males' 5K, Butte native Tony Banaovich made a triumphant return from his current home in Shelby. Banovich legged the course in 16:34, 47 seconds ahead of runner-up Tor Gudmundson of Norway who is currently a junior at Montana Tech. In 1983, Banovich established the still standing 5K course record of 15:04.

John Dunn of Butte timed 47:37 to chop nearly ten minutes off his 5K wheelchair division record that he set in last year's race.

In the Big Butte 11K, Jeff Thomas, a Montana Tech computer science graduate who is employed in Butte's Montana Power Company office, has run all seven editions, and this year he captured his third overall victory with a time of 41:55 which bested second place finisher David Mueller of Butte by over five minutes. Impressively, Thomas' average finish time for his six runnings of the current 11K course is 42 minutes even.

Female 11K course record holder Mary Murphy of Butte also won her third 11K title with a time of 54:05. Although her time was 10 seconds slower than her 1984 course record time of 53:55, she was still 12 seconds ahead of second place Penny Johnson who also resides in Butte.
