As recapped by Pat Kearney: A family connection was back in the winner's circle in 1988. This time the connection was the Stingley family of Great Falls. Bob Stingley won the men's portion of the race in a time of 28:35.9. The previous year his wife, Jacque, took top honors in the ladies race. Bob and Jacque Stingley became the first husband-wife team to win

the race.

For the first time in eight years the women's race was captured by a Butte runner. Susan Kuluza was the first to cross the line in 34:52.

Russ Erickson of Butte was the top boys' runner in the 14 and under category with a clocking of 15:30, while Cassie Floras of Great Falls took the girls' division in 22:03.
